POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION TITLE: Poker Dealer

DEPARTMENT: Table Games/Poker Room

STATUS: Full and Part Time, Regular

LEVEL OF RESPONSIBILITY: Reports to Poker Room Shift Supervisor

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Responsible for conducting operation of games by following prescribed dealing procedures. Dealers are also responsible for assisting in the general operation of the Poker Room. General duties, when not dealing, will consist mostly of customer service, seating players, getting player chips and seeing to player comfort. Acquire and maintain through knowledge of the different games and the Poker Room operation to respond to patron questions, both general and specific.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Conduct the games as assigned.
2. Assume responsibility and control of money and chips
3. Follow specific dealing procedures.
4. Maintain high degree of customer service.
5. Perform other related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION: High School Diploma or G.E.D.

EXPERIENCE: A minimum of one year experience as a poker dealer or satisfactory completion of the Sax & Fox Poker Dealing Course. Personable, customer service oriented. Work well with the public. Must be available for any and all hours/days and be able to rotate shifts if required

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must be 18 at time of hire. All employees must successfully pass a background investigation to be employed by the Casino. Responsible for compliance with the Casino's Internal Control Policy and Procedure as it relates to the position's stated job description.
